The Parasitological Society of Southern Africa (PARSA) is delighted to invite you to a three-day international congress on PARASITES OF WILDLIFE, to be held at the state-of-the-art Nombole Mdluli Conference Centre in Skukuza, the main tourist centre of the world-famous Kruger National Park. The optional fourth day (28 September 2017) will be devoted to workshops.

All parasitologists (in the fields of biology, zoology, veterinary science, etc.) are invited to participate. Abstracts of studies on parasites of free-ranging as well as captive wildlife species will be considered for either oral or poster presentation. One of the planned session will focus on the management of parasitoses in captive wildlife.

The scientific programme will start early (08:00) and end at 15:00 every afternoon, allowing ample time for game drives in the late afternoon. All delegates will stay in Skukuza where accommodation has provisionally been booked. Accommodation ranges from luxury, river-view bungalows, self-catering bungalows and bungalows without kitchen facilities to two-bedded tents (communal ablutions) and campsites. All accommodation units have their own barbecue facilities. Tariff per unit per night is for one or two persons; there is a fee for a third person sharing the accommodation. The comfortable, ensuite, thatch-roofed bungalows have either 2 or 3 single beds and are rented on a room-only basis. Skukuza camp has a cafeteria, a restaurant and a well-stocked shop that offers basic commodities (e.g. groceries, bread, vegetables, drinks, meat, toiletries, etc.). All coffee & tea breaks, lunches, the welcome reception and the gala dinner are included in the registration fees.

- Oral presentations: 15 minutes, which includes a few minutes for questions.
- Please ensure that e-mail addresses as submitted are correct, as these addresses will be used in all correspondence and acceptance notifications.
- Maximum length: 250 words
- Late submissions will not be considered

- Deadline for submission of abstracts: 14 March 2017 (Decision of scientific programme committee to be announced by 15 April 2017)
- Deadline for early-bird registration: 31 May 2017
- Deadline for regular registration: 31 July 2017
- Deadline for accommodation payments: 31 July 2017

Accommodation

- Accommodation has been reserved at Skukuza, Kruger National Park. SAVETCON has negotiated a 10% discount on the normal rates. The discounted rates are only applicable if booking is made through SAVETCON.
- Registration is a pre-requisite for booking of accommodation
- All accommodation bookings will require a 50% deposit within 7 days of the reservation and the balance by 31 July 2017.
- Delegates wishing to extend their stay in Kruger Park, i.e. enter the park prior to 23 September 2017 or leave the park after 29 September 2017, should book that accommodation separately and directly with SANParks
